### *Linked Bachelor's-Masters Program in CE*

- The Linked BS-MS degree program allows the application of up to 9 credits toward a master's degree program in Civil Engineering or Environmental Engineering for qualifying 400-level and above course work taken at the undergraduate level at MSU or an external accredited institution.
  - The department welcomes applications from MSU Civil Engineering undergraduate students in their junior and senior year.
  - Admission applications must be made a year in advance of graduation—i.e., during the prior Spring semester for an anticipated Spring graduation or the prior Fall semester for an anticipated Fall graduation to allow admission before the final semester as a CE undergraduate.
  - Admission to the program requires a minimum undergraduate grade-point average of 3.5 and an approved program of study for the Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering or Environmental Engineering at the time of admission.
  - The number of approved credits, not to exceed 9, are applied toward the credit requirement of the master's degree.
  - Credits applied to the Linked BS-MS Program are not eligible to be applied to any other graduate degree program.
