The Air & Waste management Association's Student Poster Competition recognizes student extended abstracts and posters to be the best amongst those considered in each of the following categories:

UNDERGRADUATE

1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place

MASTERS

1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place

DOCTORAL

1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place

To be eligible for this award, an individual must be:

1. a student enrolled in an institution in the category of competition
2. the primary author of the extended abstract to be presented at the A&WMA Annual Conference and Exhibition
3. designated to compete in only one competition per authored research.

To be considered for this competition, the author must submit to the Oasis Abstract Management System a one page abstract. Students are encouraged to address any subjects related to air and waste issues. These topics will be considered and judged equally for:

- Technical quality
- Relevance and significance to current environmental issues related to air and waste
- Lack of commercialism

along with the following information, both by **December 5, 2008**:

- Name
- Contact Information
- Institution Name
- Category (Undergraduate, Masters, Doctoral)
