

Air & Waste Management Association's Platform Paper Award

The Air & Waste Management Association's (A&WMA) Platform Paper Award acknowledges up to two exceptional technical papers that are written by authors at the academic levels of Master and Doctoral student. The recipients of the award will be determined by judges from the A&WMA membership. To be eligible for this award, an individual must:

- 1) Be a Master or Doctoral student at the time of the abstract submittal deadline (December 5, 2008);
- 2) Be the primary author of the paper to be presented at the A&WMA Annual Conference and Exhibition;
- 3) Present paper as a platform presentation at the Annual Conference.

To be considered for the Platform Paper Award, the author must submit the following information to Sandi Spratt, Education Associate, at sspratt@awma.org, as well as submit a draft full manuscript both by March 13, 2009:

- Name
- Contact Information: including your e-mail address and mailing address
- Abstract No.
- Confirmation by e-mail from your academic advisor to sspratt@awma.org that you are the primary author of the paper

Please note that you must meet the final manuscript deadline of April 10, 2009 to maintain your eligibility.

Students are welcome to present the same work as a student poster and as a technical paper during ACE. However, only one format (poster or technical paper) will be considered for an award. Posters are considered for awards under a separate program.
