

Questions and Answers for Summer Programs

1. Do you offer Scholarships?

The program fee is already substantially lower than our counterpart programs around the nation due to sponsorships from various industry partners that offsets the cost. The program fee covers tuition, fees, room and board, social activities, equipment, supplies, and risk management insurance.

2. For residential programs, do students have to spend the night?

Yes, this is part of the residential program experience and they must spend the night. Students do not spend the night in commuter programs.

3. Who will be watching the students in the dorms?

Our team of mentors constantly supervises students. The mentors also stay in the dorms during the duration of the stay.

4. Do they need to bring spending money?

The only things students will need spending money for are souvenirs or extra snacks. However, we are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

5. May students bring snacks?

Students are allowed to bring snacks.

6. Will the students need to bring linens?

Linens are provided, however, we strongly encourage you to bring your own to feel more comfortable. (Sheets are size twin extra long.)

7. Will students that travel by plane be picked up at the airport?

Students can be picked up at only the Lansing airport the first day of the program. Please contact us before booking the flight.

8. May students have visitors during their stay?

Due to security issues, we do not permit any visitors.

9. May students leave campus?

No, due to safety concerns we do not allow students to leave campus.

10. May students drive themselves?

No, in order to park in University parking lots you must have a permit.

11. Will students be able to choose their roommate?

We believe that meeting new people is a part of the experience. Therefore, we do not allow students to choose their own roommate. By doing this, students learn how to adapt to new environments.
