Dear Mr. Winer:

On May 5, 1993, Mike Bolas of Ohio EPA's Division of Emergency and Remedial Response, and Mark Bergman and I of Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management, conducted a complaint investigation of one of your vehicle storage facilities. The facility investigated was behind (south of) a building where old military vehicles, such as tankers, are stored. The complainant alleged illegal storage of waste solvents in the tankers. Our investigation showed no evidence of solvent storage in any of the military tankers at the site. The only material found at the site was diesel fuel in the fuel tanks of some of the vehicles.

At this time, this agency has determined the complaint to be unfounded and no further action will be taken.

Aerial photograph:

- Fill area SE of old bar/restaurant: demo debris, large chunks of concrete, gravel, mixed with soil. Area field verified and confirmed by local long-time area resident.

- Fill area at intersection of creek and Waterloo Rd; House now exists on top of fill area. Resident states that he built the house himself. The "fill area" was street cleanings brought in by the resident to raise the grade of his future home. Fill consists of gravel and grass with some leaves.
