Dr. R. Taylor Scott is a Family Medicine physician who works both at MSU and at McLaren Greater Lansing where he serves as the Family Medicine Residency Program, training young Family Medicine physicians. He went to college and Medical School at MSU and is board certified in Family Medicine. He has special interest in Medical Education and became interested in Street Medicine as an instructor at MSU when a student approached him with a need. He is currently Co-Advisor to Spartan Street Medicine which is a student run group of volunteer doctors that provide basic care to the underserved in the Lansing area on a volunteer basis. He and co-advisor Dr. Graham Atkin have been doing this work in the Lansing area for over six years.

Dr. Graham Atkin, PhD, is an Assistant Professor in the Departments of Radiology and Neurology at MSU where he teaches medical students, neurology residents, and undergraduates about the brain. He trained in neuroscience at the University of Michigan and has worked with marginalized populations through community and nonprofit groups for over 20 years. He was honored to be asked to serve as a founding Co-Advisor for Spartan Street Medicine alongside Dr. Taylor Scott.
