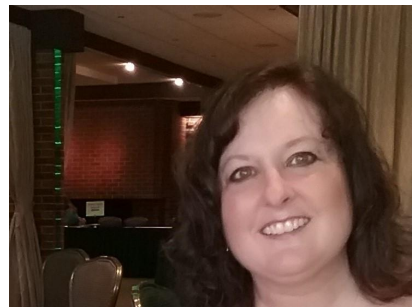

MSU COLLEGE ASSISTANCE MIGRANT PROGRAM NEEDS THE COMMUNITY'S SUPPORT



At the February 14 program we learned that the MSU College Assistance Migrant Program's student body can use the support of the MSU community. MSU CAMP is an educational program that offers individuals with migrant or seasonal farm work backgrounds, a unique opportunity to begin an undergraduate program at MSU.

The residential program assists migrant and seasonal farm worker students with academic, social, and financial support. Elias Lopez, Senior Associate Director of CAMP, shared with us that the program aids students by having a supply of the following items available.

- Toiletries (shampoo, bar soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss, deodorant, hair brushes, combs, face lotion, and sanitizer, and band-aids.
- Detergent
- Professional wear for both men and women (for job interviews)
- Coats (for cold weather)
