MSU Safe Place was founded in 1994 by Joanne McPherson, MSU's First Lady from 1993-2004. It was the first "domestic violence shelter and support service on a college campus in the United States (MSU Safe Place website)." Joanne McPherson asked for support and fundraising assistance from the Faculty Folk Club, now MSU Community Club. The club responded generously and continues to support this cause. MSU Safe Place provides safe temporary shelter and support services to the entire MSU community from students through staff and their young children. They advocate for victims in the legal system and social service agencies. They educate the community about these issues and their services and offer volunteer and internship position for season.
