## **APRIL 7, 2018 TASTE OF THE TOWN ~ THE GRAND FINALE**

Twenty-three restaurants, caterers and beverage establishments provided a "smorgasbord of culinary delights" for the 441 ticket holders at the 30th Anniversary Celebration of Taste of the Town. This event has been the major fund raiser for the MSU Community Club, which provides Endowed Scholarships for MSU students needing financial assistance.

A total of \$15,394.00 in ticket sales and additional donations was collected. After expenses totaling \$1,721.00, \$13,673.00 was deposited to the Endowment which is sustainable with earnings that will provide funding for scholarships to MSU students for many years and help them successfully achieve their academic and professional goals.

Donations have also been received from several MSUCC interest groups (i.e., MSU Spartan Quilters and Dollars for Scholars to name a few).

The very dedicated group of committee members included Chairperson Karen Harsh; Mary Ann Dunn, Kathy Esselman, Ruth Ann Brunet, Gretchen Forsyth, Jacqueline Foss, Debra Gift, Suzanne Laningham, Janet Moeller, Geri Potchen, Marty Simonds, Barb Sjolander, Mariellyn Stevenson, RoseAnn Swartz and Carol Terry. All have had specific assignments and have served diligently with devotion, expertise, enthusiasm and great pride striving to build on past successes while in constant pursuit of excellence.
